The new insulation under the roof is almost complete. Wall framing is ongoing, and framing of soffits and ceilings will start in the coming days. Duct for the HVAC system, sprinkler pipe, electrical conduit, and plumbing systems are all in the process of being installed. The roof replacement over phase 2 areas is ongoing as well, and the flat roof portion is nearly complete. It will be followed by shingle replacement on the sloped roofs.
