Dear Residents, Families and Staff:

Phoebe Pharmacy will be distributing the COVID-19 bivalent booster vaccine for our residents in Residential Living in our Arts & Crafts room on Wednesday, September 21, 2022. Detailed information including requirements, instructions, time slots, and consent forms will be placed in your mailboxes and on Touchtown. If you have already received a booster dose or decide to receive it outside of Dunwoody, please bring a copy of your card to Health & Wellness to update your records.

All Care Center residents who have signed a consent form, both Skilled and Personal Care, will also be offered the bivalent COVID-19 booster vaccine on Wednesday, September 21, 2022; vaccines will be distributed in each unit of the Care Center.

Staff will be offered the bivalent COVID-19 booster vaccine and dates are being planned.

Additionally, we are planning for distribution of the flu vaccine for resident and staff and will provide an update as soon as possible.

COVID-19

Currently there are no Care Center nor any Residential residents who have tested positive for COVID-19. Two staff members are positive and at home on isolation.

Drywall is still being hung and finished on both levels, and the painter is priming and first coating walls and ceilings. Ceiling grid is being installed in many areas, and lights, sprinkler, and HVAC diffusers are being installed in the grid. The new windows in the Lounge and Lobby are starting to be installed as well. The epoxy floor in the phase 2 kitchen areas, as well as the back of bar and future dessert area in the Bistro, will begin next week. Tile flooring in the hallway between the Phase 2 kitchen and Fox Den should be complete in the next couple of days. The installer will then tile the future Trolley Stop.
