COVID-19

Eleven Residential residents and nine Care Center residents have tested positive and are on quarantine. Ten staff members have tested positive and are at home on isolation.

Masks for Staff & Visitors

Effective immediately, and continuing through January 10, 2023, all staff and contractors are required to wear masks unless alone in a private office. All visitors are required to wear masks in the common areas of Residential living, but may remove their masks in private residences or while sitting at a table and eating or drinking in one of our dining venues.

While masks are not required for Residential residents, Dr. Lawrence, our Medical Director, strongly recommends that all residents wear masks in common areas.

Dining

Christmas Day, Sunday, December 25th

Reservations are now full for Christmas Day dining. Reservations for holiday dining is limited to a party of 6 persons or less per household and double booking of table is not permitted. For the Christmas meal, you may use one meal plan and the cost of a guest is \$21.00. Takeout will be available in the auditorium from 11:30 – 1:00 pm. No reservations are needed for takeout .

New Year's Eve celebration will be held in the Auditorium from 4:30 – 6:30 p.m. on Saturday, December 31st. Cocktails & heavy hors d'oeuvres will be served. Additional dining will not be available that evening. To-go is not available for New Year's Eve.

New Year's Day brunch will be normal Sunday brunch hours 12:00 pm – 1:30pm.

Additional Dining Information

- Reservations for 1712 are limited to 6 persons or less, per household, at all times.
- The desert station is moved to its permanent location – next to the salad station.
- Morning coffee is now served in the Fox Den.

Door 1 (Transportation)

When our Front Lobby was closed, the temporary main entrance and reception desk moved to Door 1. Now that the new Main Lobby is open, Door 1 will be locked. Staff such as Mailroom and Transportation will be using Door 1. **All staff should enter only through the Main Lobby or Care Center Lobby. All visitors, delivery persons and contractors should enter Only through the Main Lobby or Care Center Lobby. Accushield screening is set up in the Main Lobby and Care Center Lobby and screening must occur for all staff and visitors entering Dunwoody Village.** No one other than residents should enter Dunwoody without passing the receptionist and passing a COVID screen on Accushield in either the Main Lobby or Care Center Lobby.
