Parking on Campus

Employees are reminded they are only permitted to park in employee designated areas. Employees should never park in the Care Center lot nor Lot A near the main entrance. All vehicles must have a current inspection sticker.

Residents are reminded that if they have a valid driver's license and insurance on file, and they have a car with a current inspection on campus, they are assigned one parking spot in a surface lot as close to their unit as is possible. If there is a second car in the residence and all of the above requirements are met, an additional parking space will be assigned. The second parking space may not be in the same area as the first. There is a fee for an assigned parking spot in a car port. Additionally, no resident should park overnight in identified Handicap Parking or in Lot A. These spaces are for residents driving to meals, programs or appointments in the Village. We appreciate your compliance with the Dunwoody Parking Policies.
