On Monday evening during the storm, we lost a longtime friend, our White Ash tree. In September of 2022 the White Ash was recognized and accepted into the Pennsylvania Big Tree Registry. Measuring 233 inches in circumference, 89 feet high and with a spread of 97 feet, our White Ash was the largest in Delaware County, and the 5th largest in PA! Many residents, staff and visitors commented on its stature and enjoyed its beauty. Our White Ash will be missed but please know Shriner's has taken the logs and is storing them for us so that we can use the wood in a meaningful way at Dunwoody.

There has been some "buzz" about artwork in our new common spaces. Please know that familiar and important pieces of art, like the portrait of our founder, William Hood Dunwoody, will return to a place of prominence. Additionally, there will be designated space to feature the art of our very talented Dunwoody residents near the lobby. These areas are being identified in partnership with the Resident Art Committee.
