Voting Registration & Mail-In Ballots

The primary election is Tuesday, April 23, 2024. The last day to register to vote is April 8, 2024, and the last day to apply for a mail-in ballot is April 16, 2024. For Dunwoody Village residents, your state representation District is #168 and Precinct #2. If you have recently moved in to Dunwoody, you need to update your registration with your current address. If you have recently moved from Residential to Personal Care or Skilled Nursing, you will also need to update your registration information, because your address is changed from your Residential residence to Care Center room number.

There are hard copies of the voter registration form and applications for mail in ballots in the Marketing office. If you fill out a form, you will mail it to 201 W. Front St. Government Center Bldg. Media, PA 19063. Kayla will email links for voter registration, mail-in ballot application, and status of mail in ballots to complete the forms online.
