Dear Residents, Staff and Families,

As you know, the work group consisting of board members, residents and staff completed their work on Mission Vision and Values on May 29, 2024. The committee, using the process of Appreciative Inquiry to focus on all that is positive at Dunwoody Village, interviewed over 85 board members, residents, staff and families. The group reconvened to identify the themes that were heard in the interviews. These themes were then compared to the current Mission, Vision and Values so that missing themes could be incorporated. The draft was presented to the committee on May 29th for their recommendations and based on the feedback, a final version was drafted. On June 11th the Healthcare and Strategic Planning Committee recommended that the draft Mission, Vision and Values be presented to the Board of Trustees for their approval. Steve Ruzansky and Monica Knauss presented the draft to the Dunwoody Village Residents Association at their meeting on June 11th.

I am pleased to share that the Board of Trustees approved the Dunwoody Village Mission, Vision and Values. This was important work during our anniversary year, celebrating 100 years of the Dunwoody Home and 50 years of Dunwoody Village. Our renewed Mission, Vision and Values honors our past while reflecting our current and future community. Our Mission, Vision and Values will serve as a strong guide for Strategic Planning and our future care and service.

Please join me in thanking Pat Burke, Chair of the Healthcare and Strategic Planning Committee who led this process, Bert Dalby, Chair of the Board for his support of the process, Monica Knauss, Director of Marketing, who was able to incorporate so many of the themes identified in the true *One Dunwoody* spirit, and the residents, staff, families and board members who served as interviewers or agreed to be interviewed, sharing meaningful stories, reflections and thoughts about Dunwoody Village.
