RSV Vaccine Clinic

Health & Wellness will be offering the RSV vaccine on September 27th in the Health and Wellness Department. If you are interested in receiving the vaccine, we need to have your name **by noon on September 16th**. Phoebe Pharmacy will be administering the vaccine, and they need to verify your insurance prior to administering it to check if the cost is covered. Once we have the list of how many residents are interested, we will inform every one of the clinic's time. This is a one-time vaccine, so if you've already received it, you are not recommended to receive another dose.
