CAMPUS OPERATIONS

<u>Putting Green:</u> The Putting Green renovation is underway. The area has been cleared and prepped, crush stone is being installed for the base and forms are being installed in preparation for the sidewalk and sitting area concrete. There is a lot of heavy machinery and dangerous conditions. Please do not enter into the courtyard from the Arts and Crafts Studio, Library or West Country Corridor

<u>Memorial Garden:</u> We are excavating a few feet of foundation in portions of Memorial Garden to install water proofing below grade. This is being done to help prevent water penetration in the Lower Level of the Community Building. This work is being done by hand to prevent any impact to the plant material in the Memorial Garden. Once complete, the soil and stone will be backfilled around the permitter of the building like it was before.

<u>J-Hall Renovation:</u> The renovations in J-Hall continue to make progress. The heavy demolition is complete, the framing has been installed and the rough-in electrical and plumbing work is being done. There will continue to be times of noise for additional framing, cutting and hammering as the work continues.
