Mandatory Flu Vaccines for Staff!

We are approaching the deadline for all employees to receive their annual mandatory flu vaccination. A big THANK YOU to the 350 employees who have already received their vaccinations! For those employees who have received their flu vaccine, please note the following:

- The vaccinations are available for free at Dunwoody by contacting any nursing supervisor on any shift or by contacting Diane Host in the Fairlee Educational Center during daytime hours.
- The deadline to receive the vaccination here at Dunwoody or provide written proof that you received the vaccination somewhere else is next Saturday, November 30, 2024. Proof of the vaccine can be given to your department director.
- Requests for religious or medical exemption must be received in Human Resources by next Wednesday, November 27th. Exemption forms are available in Human Resources and must be submitted each year.
- Failure to get the vaccine or to provide an approved medical or religious exemption is considered to be a voluntary resignation because of the serious violation of our safety rules.
