The short-term rehabilitation rating evaluates a nursing home's quality of post-acute care for patients recovering from a hospital stay such as after stroke, heart attack, infection or accidental injury. The data used for long-term care ratings comes primarily from the federal Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) and includes metrics related to patient outcomes, nurse staffing, resident safety, and turnover of ownership and staff.
