Dear Residents, Families and Staff:

Baby, it's cold outside! And with the cold temperatures we are seeing illnesses like influenza, RSV and COVID. Because we have been seeing more residents with respiratory symptoms, we have an increased number of residents on droplet precautions. We have also seen residents with cases of Influenza A, RSV and COVID. Additionally, we have over 30 nursing staff and 20 home care staff who work in both Skilled Nursing and Personal Care. As such, **we are masking for 2 weeks to lessen the risk of outbreaks. Masking will be reviewed on January 23rd. If you visit a resident residing in Skilled or Personal Care, please wear a mask.** If you do not feel well or have symptoms, please refrain from visiting until you feel better.

J-Hallway Restroom

On Monday, January 13, 2025, the J-hallway public restroom will be closed for several weeks for renovation. Please use the public restrooms in the lobby as an alternative.

Lower-Level Corridor

The renovation to the lower-level corridor is set to begin the week of January 20th and is expected to take approximately 2 months to complete. This scope of work includes new flooring, paint and ceilings. We will be sure to communicate any closures which would require using alternative routes prior to starting that work. Please use caution when traveling through this area as there will be additional workers and contractors at times.
